Other Patient Guidelines

1. Provide proof of income

Acceptable documents: 1040 form **OR** three recent paycheck stubs, **OR** a notarized document from someone willing to be responsible for patient's bill

- 2. <u>Must meet income criteria</u>
- 3. Patient cannot have any type of insurance
- 4. Provide proof of address, ID, and number of individuals in the patient household

Acceptable documents: utility bill **OR** gas bill, **OR** mail that has patient's name connected with the address they are using

5. <u>Provide Social Security cards **OR** tax ID for each member being counted in the household</u>**Patients must requalify on an annual basis**
