Other Patient Guidelines

1. Provide proof of income

Acceptable documents: 1040 form **OR** three recent paycheck stubs, **OR** a notarized document from someone willing to be responsible for patient's bill

2. Must meet income criteria

3. Patient cannot have any type of insurance

4. Provide proof of address, ID, and number of individuals in the patient household

Acceptable documents: utility bill **OR** gas bill, **OR** mail that has patient's name connected with the address they are using

5. Provide Social Security cards **OR** tax ID for each member being counted in the household**Patients must requalify on an annual basis**
