Other Patient Guidelines

1. <u>Provide proof of income.</u>

Acceptable documents: 1040 form OR three recent paycheck stubs, OR a notarized document from someone willing to attest to patient's employment.

- 2. Must meet income criteria.
- 3. <u>Patient cannot have any type of insurance.</u>
- 4. <u>Provide proof of address and picture ID</u> Acceptable documents: utility bill OR gas bill, OR mail that has patient's name connected with the address they are using.
- 5. <u>Provide proof of each person being counted in the household.</u> Acceptable documents: 1040 form or social security cards for members of the household.

Patients must requalify on an annual basis
